PARTNERSHIP, COLLABORATION AND EXTERNAL EVALUATION CENTRAL TO SUCCESS IN 2018

A trailblazing partnership with Dika College set the tone for a 2018 that saw New Zealand Tertiary College (NZTC) launch new initiatives, grow international partnerships and shine during external evaluations.



NZTC kick-started the year by becoming New Zealand's first tertiary education provider to have a degree accredited by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency and the Malaysia Ministry of Higher Education, when we partnered with well-known and respected Malaysian early childhood teacher education provider Dika College who now delivers our Bachelor of Education (ECE).

The college's international influence expanded into new territory with America-based global research journal database giant EBSCO offering an invitational licensing partnership to our peer-reviewed journal *He Kupu*.

An expanding international network saw our team travel across the globe to meet face-to-face with educational partners and prospective students throughout Asia, India and Africa.

In October, we were awarded our third consecutive New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) Category One status.

NZQA was "Highly Confident" in educational performance and "Highly Confident" in self-assessment at NZTC. We were particularly proud of NZQA's acknowledgement that NZTC supports international students "exceptionally".

This came hot on the heels of the Tertiary Education Commission report illustrating that NZTC's qualification completion rates exceed both the national university and Tertiary Education Organisation average.

However, it was the *Vision, Heart, Competence* and *Spirit* of more than 800 students who graduated with NZTC qualifications in New Zealand, India and globally that we hold as our biggest achievement in 2018.
